Please provide us with your electronic papers in 4-12 complete pages by April 13, 2023, via e-mail address constantinov.valentin@upsc.md and walentkonstant@yahoo.fr, in accordance with the following editing guidelines:

- The Microsoft Word editor will be used and Times New Roman font size 12 with diacritics, line spacing 1.5, indent 1.0;
- Paper size: A4;
- Borders: Top – 2 cm; Bottom – 2 cm; Left – 2 cm; Right – 2 cm;
- The title of the paper should be capitalized, written in English and the paper language, using Times New Roman font size 14, bold, centred, and followed by the author(s) full name and surname, their institutional affiliation, country, ORCID and email, using the Times New Roman font size 12, bold, centred;
- Abstracts (800-1500 characters each) in English and paper language will be written without indent, left-right alignment and Times New Roman font size 12, line spacing 1.5.
- Keywords in English and paper language will include 3-7 conceptual terms, which will be written in the same format as the abstracts;
- Calculation formulas are incorporated in the text using the Equation Editor;
- Charts, histograms, pictures, photos, etc. are centred, only in black and white (hits and gradient are admitted) after the reference in the text; their numbering, title, legend and source shall be placed below and centred;
- Statistical tables are embedded in the text and centred, preceded by the left-oriented title;
- References, enclosed in square brackets, are inserted in the text according to the bibliographic list;
- The authors are responsible for the content of their works;
- The works are written in English, Romanian, Polish, or other reference language in the case of communications in the field of philology.;
- The works are published in the authors' edition;
- The editorial board may not share the authors' points of view;
- Bibliography is placed at the end of the paper, with Arabic numbering, according to Standard ISO 690:2012 (https://lib.upsc.md/wp-content/uploads/2020/04/Regul_Referinte_bibliografice_Ro.pdf or <https://anacec.md/files/ghid-redactare-teza-final.pdf> (page 25));
- Articles will be subject to anti-plagiarism check (antiplagiat.ro). The percentage of similarities and self-citation will not exceed 25% of the total volume of materials. For the self-assessment of your paper plagiarism degree, we suggest the following links. If non-compliant works are identified, they will be rejected.

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
