

## General information for Erasmus+ Incoming students



### **STUDYING WITH ERASMUS+ AT “ION CREANGA” STATE PEDAGOGICAL UNIVERSITY OF CHISINAU**

Students from Erasmus+ partner universities may spend one or two semesters at our university within the Erasmus+ Programme. The student must be nominated for an Erasmus+ mobility at “Ion Creanga” State Pedagogical University of Chisinau by his/her home university. Therefore, you cannot apply for an Erasmus+ mobility by yourself directly.

### **NOMINATION BY HOME UNIVERSITY**

Please contact the Erasmus/International Office of your home university in order to be nominated as an Erasmus+ student at “Ion Creanga” State Pedagogical University of Chisinau. This implies that an Erasmus+ inter-institutional agreement, assigned to

a relevant field of study, exists between the two universities, stipulating that the study period in the signatory institutions will be mutually recognised. Your home Erasmus/International Office will subsequently send us the official nomination by e-mail to [erasmus.plus@upsc.md](mailto:erasmus.plus@upsc.md) with the information below:

- name, surname
- email address
- period of study
- field of study and level (bachelor’s/master’s/doctoral programme)

**Deadlines for student nomination:**  
**Autumn semester/Full year:** 15 May  
**Spring semester:** 15 November

### **APPLICATION FILE**

The application file includes the documents listed below:

- Learning Agreement – to be filled in electronically using the information in the Course Catalogue (link) and sent in WORD format to

[erasmus.plus@upsc.md](mailto:erasmus.plus@upsc.md) to be verified. After verification, print two originals and have them signed by you and your academic/departmental/faculty coordinator.

- Transcript of records in English – issued by your faculty/university.
- Copy of passport.
- Health insurance for the entire period of stay.
- Health certificate issued by your personal doctor. The student will bring the written translation of the document in English.

The **SCANNED (verified)** documents in the application file will be sent to [erasmus.plus@upsc.md](mailto:erasmus.plus@upsc.md)

The **ORIGINALS (Learning Agreements)** will be brought to the International Relations and Project Management Office (bl. 2, office 25) when you arrive to Chisinau.

**Deadlines for sending the documents:**  
**Autumn semester/Full year:** 15 June  
**Spring semester:** 1st December

### **ACADEMIC CALENDAR**

The **academic year** begins on September 1st and ends on June 30th (summer exam session included). Depending on the faculty, a bachelor's degree takes 3 to 4 years to complete, whereas a master's degree takes 1,5 - 2 years (3-4 semesters). In the latter case, the courses are held in the afternoon to allow employed students to attend it.

- Autumn semester – begins around on September 1st, includes the Christmas holiday (2 weeks) and ends on January 31st, after the winter exam session.
- Spring semester – starts on February 1st, includes the Easter holiday (1 week) and ends around June 30th, with the summer exam session (depending on the faculty).
